About

We live in a culture on the run. Busyness is worn as a badge of honor, even if we are busy for the sake of being busy. This 31-day reading plan is intended to help you live counter culturally. It is designed to assist you in slowing down and breathing in the life of the Spirit. Specifically, these passages are focused on the life and ministry of Jesus.

Each passage is carefully selected for being major events in Jesus' life which reveal his identity and character. Each selection is approximately 20 verses in length. This specific list of passages is divided into seven sections and balanced between the four gospels.

Two of the sections use readings outside of the Gospels. *Jesus Foretold* includes four passages from the Old Testament that look forward to the coming of Jesus. *Resurrection* includes a passage from Acts and Revelation that show Jesus is alive and is active in his church today.

Tips for Bible Reading and Prayer

Place and Time

Find a consistent time and place with minimal distractions.

Prav

Begin with prayer by giving God praise. Then ask God to give you wisdom and insight into his Word.

Read

Slow down. Read to understand and not simply to get through the passage.

Reflect on the following questions:

Some people prefer to write out their answers in a journal.

- What was the author's intended meaning?
- What does this passage tell us about Jesus?
- What does this passage tell us about mankind?
- How can I apply this passage to my life?

Prav

Praise Jesus for his marvelous works. Ask Jesus to give you strength for this day.
